Official communiqué of the 8800th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday,
18 June 2021, at 10.30 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 8800th meeting, held in private on 18 June 2021, the Security Council considered the item entitled “The situation in Myanmar”.

“The President invited the following briefers to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure: Ms. Christine Schraner Burgener, Special Envoy of the Secretary-General for Myanmar; and His Excellency Dato Erywan Pehin Yusof, Foreign Minister II of Brunei Darussalam, in his capacity as Chair of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations.

“The Council heard briefings by Ms. Schraner Burgener and His Excellency Dato Pehin Yusof.

“Statements were made by the representatives of the United Kingdom, Ireland, the United States, France, Kenya, Mexico, Norway, the Russian Federation, India, Niger, Viet Nam, Tunisia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, China, and by the President, speaking in his capacity as the representative of Estonia.

“Ms. Schraner Burgener and His Excellency Dato Pehin Yusof responded to comments and questions raised.”
