ARRANGEMENTS FOR A PERIODIC VISITING MISSION
TO TRUST TERRITORIES IN EAST AFRICA IN 1957

Note by the Secretary-General

At its 787th meeting, on 3 May 1957, the Trusteeship Council decided to dispatch to Trust Territories in East Africa, in 1957, a visiting mission composed of persons nominated by Australia, Burma, France and Haiti.

In pursuance of the foregoing decision, the Government of Haiti informed the Secretary-General that it had nominated Ambassador Max H. Dorsinville, representative of Haiti on the Trusteeship Council, as a member of the Visiting Mission.
