**Lettre datée du 6 août 2021, adressée au Secrétaire
général par le Représentant permanent de Chypre
auprès de l'Organisation des Nations Unies**

D'ordre de mon gouvernement, j'ai l'honneur de vous faire tenir ci-joint, dans quatre annexes distinctes, la liste des violations de l'espace aérien de Chypre et de la réglementation internationale de la circulation aérienne dans la région d'information de vol de Chypre commises par la Turquie et celle des cas d'utilisation illégale, par ce pays, de ports et d'aéroports chypriotes fermés, pendant les mois d'avril et de mai 2021 (voir annexes I à IV*).

L'aviation civile internationale reste confrontée à une situation où l'un des États membres de l'Organisation de l'aviation civile internationale (OACI), à savoir la Turquie, ne respecte pas les dispositions fondamentales de la Convention relative à l'aviation civile internationale et de ses annexes, ce qui fait peser des risques sur la navigation aérienne internationale. La Turquie continue, par des appels radios, de harceler systématiquement les appareils civils et militaires circulant à l'intérieur de la région d'information de vol de Nicosie. Par ailleurs, le régime sécessionniste qu'elle a mis en place dans la partie de Chypre se trouvant sous son occupation militaire illégale a reçu l'ordre de publier six « avis aux navigateurs aériens » concernant des manœuvres organisées par l'armée de l'air turque.

Par ces actes, la Turquie vise clairement à porter atteinte à la souveraineté de Chypre, à accentuer la division de fait de l'île et à renforcer le statut du régime sécessionniste en alléguant l'existence d'un espace aérien distinct au-dessus du territoire occupé de Chypre. À cet égard, il convient de rappeler que, comme le disposent, entre autres, diverses résolutions du Conseil de sécurité, notamment les résolutions [541 \(1983\)](#) et [550 \(1984\)](#), il n'existe qu'un seul État chypriote, à savoir la République de Chypre et que, par conséquent, pour l'OACI, la République de Chypre est le seul État internationalement reconnu compétent pour assurer des services de contrôle aérien dans l'ensemble de la région d'information de vol de Nicosie et diffuser des informations aéronautiques concernant cette région d'information de vol. Les aéroports situés dans la zone occupée de Chypre, la création du prétendu « espace aérien à service consultatif d'Ercan » ou encore les groupes de « services consultatifs sur le

trafic aérien d'Ercan » et de « contrôle du trafic aérien » (qui ne figurent pas dans le plan régional de navigation aérienne) sont illégaux et, par conséquent, leurs activités sont nulles et non avenues et ne sont pas prises en compte, sur le plan opérationnel, par la navigation aérienne internationale et la communauté de l'aviation civile.

Le comportement agressif de la Turquie et le mépris persistant dont fait preuve ce pays à l'égard du droit international, tel que reflété dans les résolutions pertinentes du Conseil de sécurité, ont atteint de nouveaux sommets en juillet 2021, ce qui compromet encore plus les droits humains, déjà violés, des habitants légitimes de Varosha et nuit gravement aux perspectives de règlement du problème de Chypre.

Pour être plus précis, le 20 juillet 2021, le Président turc, agissant au mépris flagrant de la déclaration explicite sur Varosha du Président du Conseil de sécurité, en date du 9 octobre 2020 ([S/PRST/2020/9](#)), ainsi que des avertissements lancés à ce sujet par les acteurs internationaux, y compris l'Union européenne, a annoncé avec le dirigeant chypriote turc « la deuxième phase de l'ouverture de Varosha ».

La Turquie a de nouveau démontré, le 23 juillet 2021, qu'elle fait fi de l'ordre international fondé sur des règles : le Ministère turc des affaires étrangères a publié un communiqué de presse (n° 260) dans lequel des termes irrespectueux ont été utilisés à l'égard du Conseil de sécurité qui, dans l'exercice des fonctions qui lui sont confiées par la Charte, a adopté le même jour une déclaration de son président ([S/PRST/2021/13](#)) condamnant les annonces turques susmentionnées sur Varosha. Le Ministère des affaires étrangères déclare sans ambages qu'il rejette le document [S/PRST/2021/13](#) et demande à « la communauté internationale de regarder en face les réalités sur l'île ». Le 29 juillet, il a publié un communiqué de presse tout aussi provocateur (n° 265) concernant la résolution [2587 \(2021\)](#) du Conseil de sécurité sur la prorogation du mandat de la Force de maintien de la paix des Nations Unies à Chypre, dans lequel il demande notamment que « le Conseil de sécurité et la communauté internationale se concentrent sur la recherche d'un règlement fondé sur les réalités ».

La Turquie s'accroche imperturbablement à sa perception de la « réalité », laquelle a conduit la réunion informelle 5+1 sur Chypre (27-29 avril 2021) à une issue peu concluante. Lors de la visite illégale qu'il a effectuée dans la zone occupée de Chypre le 20 juillet 2021, le Président turc a demandé de nouveau la « reconnaissance de l'existence de deux États à Chypre », en contradiction flagrante avec les dispositions des résolutions pertinentes du Conseil de sécurité, des paramètres établis par l'ONU et l'ensemble des travaux existants.

Les soi-disant « réalités sur le terrain » dont parle la Turquie sont en fait la situation qu'elle a créée à Chypre par le recours à la force, en violation de l'Article 2 de la Charte des Nations Unies, ainsi que l'occupation militaire d'un tiers du territoire de la République de Chypre. La Turquie exige que la communauté internationale reconnaisse les changements découlant de l'agression, conformément à la doctrine révolue du droit de conquête, et déclare ouvertement qu'elle continuera à violer les résolutions du Conseil de sécurité, au mépris total de l'Article 25 de la Charte.

Le Conseil de sécurité doit affirmer ses résolutions et s'employer à les faire prévaloir, faute de quoi, la crédibilité du système international serait compromise.

En dépit de tous les obstacles, nous restons attachés à un règlement reposant sur le principe d'une fédération bizonale et bicommunautaire dotée de l'égalité politique, telle que défini dans de nombreuses résolutions du Conseil de sécurité. À cet égard, nous nous félicitons de la persistance et de la détermination avec laquelle vous soutenez les efforts en faveur d'une reprise des négociations officielles, telles qu'exprimées dans vos derniers rapports au Conseil de sécurité.

Je vous serais reconnaissant de bien vouloir faire distribuer le texte de la présente lettre et de ses annexes comme document de l'Assemblée générale, au titre du point 44 de l'ordre du jour, et du Conseil de sécurité.
