The meeting was called to order at 12.40 p.m.

Agenda item 5: Election of the officers of the Main Committees

1. The Chair said that, in accordance with rule 99 (a) of the rules of procedure, the meeting had been convened for the purpose of electing the Chair and other members of the Bureau of the Committee for the seventy-sixth session of the General Assembly.

2. The nomination of Ms. Al-Thani (Qatar) for the post of Chair had been endorsed by the Group of Asia-Pacific States. In the absence of further nominations, and in accordance with rule 103 of the rules of procedure, he would take it that the Committee wished to elect Ms. Al-Thani (Qatar) Chair.

3. *Ms. Al-Thani (Qatar) was elected Chair by acclamation.*

4. **The Chair**, said that the nominations of Mr. Abdelaziz (Egypt), Ms. Krutulytė (Lithuania), and Mr. García López (Spain) for the three posts of Vice-Chair had been endorsed by the Group of African States, the Group of Eastern European States the Group of Western European and other States, respectively, and that, in the case of the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States, Ms. Villalobos (Costa Rica) had been nominated for the post of Rapporteur.

5. *Mr. Abdelaziz (Egypt), Ms. Krutulytė (Lithuania), and Mr. García López (Spain) were elected Vice-Chairs, and Ms. Villalobos (Costa Rica) was elected Rapporteur, by acclamation.*
