ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE UNITED NATIONS VISITING MISSION TO THE  
TRUST TERRITORIES OF TOGOLAND UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION  
AND TOGOLAND UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION, 1955

Note by the Secretary-General

At its 615th meeting on 14 June 1955, the Council appointed, on the nomination of the Government of Australia, Mr. J. C. G. Kevin as a member of the United Nations Visiting Mission to the Trust Territories of Togoland under British administration and Togoland under French administration, 1955.

In this connexion, the Permanent Representative of Australia to the United Nations informed the Secretary-General by a letter dated 1 July 1955 that Mr. Kevin would unfortunately not be available to serve on the Visiting Mission and that, in substitution for Mr. Kevin, the Government of Australia desired to nominate Mr. John Mill McMillan, Counsellor, Department of External Affairs, Canberra.
