DEVELOPMENT PLANS IN NON-SELF-GOVERNING TERRITORIES

In 1950 summaries were prepared of the information transmitted up to that year, showing the principal plans of development which were operating in the Non-Self-Governing Territories, the administrative methods, finance and progress achieved in the execution of these plans.<sup>1/</sup> The subject of the economic objectives and general aspects of development programmes was also dealt with in a series of studies which formed the basis of discussions in the Committee on Information during its 1951 session, when it last paid special attention to economic conditions and problems of development in the Non-Self-Governing Territories.<sup>2/</sup>

Studies are being prepared for the 1954 session of the Committee, showing by regions (Africa, Asia-Pacific, Caribbean) recent estimates and expenditure in respect of the development plans; the sources of development funds; and examples of the progress made in the implementation of the plans. A more general study will analyse some of the problems which have been encountered in the implementation of the plans, any major revisions and certain aspects of progress made in the basic operation of the plans, particularly in respect of the participation of the inhabitants.
