### Report of the Secretary-General

1. At its 78th plenary meeting, on 11 June 2021, the General Assembly elected Albania, Brazil, Gabon, Ghana and the United Arab Emirates as non-permanent members of the Security Council for a term of two years beginning on 1 January 2022.
