Note by the Secretary-General

As a result of decisions taken by the Council at its forty-first session, the following items are to be considered by the Council at meetings of the resumed session to be held at Headquarters during or shortly after the twenty-first session of the General Assembly:

1. Financing of economic development: establishment of a United Nations Capital Development Fund
2. Report of the Trade and Development Board
3. Implementation of a five-year survey programme for the development of natural resources.
4. Establishment of an International Institute for Documentation on Housing, Building and Planning
5. Date and site of the International Symposium on Industrial Development
6. Calendar of conferences for 1967
7. Elections
8. Confirmation of members of functional commissions of the Council
9. Basic programme of work of the Council in 1967 and consideration of the provisional agenda for the forty-second session

ANNOTATIONS TO THE ITEMS ON THE AGENDA FOR THE  
RESUMED FORTY-FIRST SESSION OF THE COUNCIL

1. Financing of economic development: establishment of a United Nations Capital Development Fund

The Council will have before it General Assembly resolution 2042 (XX) and the report of the Committee on the United Nations Capital Development Fund on its session held from 12 to 16 September 1966 (A/6418). The relevant parts of the report of the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme on its session in June 1966 (E/4219) will also be available to the Council, as will the report prepared by the Secretary-General for the Committee on a United Nations Capital Development Fund, pursuant to General Assembly resolution 2042 (XX) (A/AC.102/9).

2. Report of the Trade and Development Board

Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 1995 (XIX), paragraph 22, the Board reports annually on its activities to the General Assembly through the Economic and Social Council. The third session of the Board took place from 25 January to 16 February and the fourth session from 30 August to 24 September 1966. The report of the Board (A/6315) is expected to be issued in the latter part of October.

3. Implementation of a five-year survey programme for the development of natural resources

The Council will have before it the interim report to be prepared by the Secretary-General pursuant to Council resolution 1127 (XLI).

4. Establishment of an International Institute for Documentation on Housing, Building and Planning

In its resolution 1166 (XLI), the Council requested the Secretary-General to complete the necessary consultations and negotiations on the functions, organization, administrative arrangements and financing of the International Institute and to report on the subject to the Council at the resumed forty-first session.

5. Date and site of the International Symposium on Industrial Development

At its 1445th meeting, on 5 August 1966, the Council took note of the offers of the Governments of Guatemala and India to act as hosts to the International Symposium on Industrial Development to be held during 1967, and requested the

implications of holding the Symposium at the sites in question. Consequently, the Council deferred a decision on the date and site of the Symposium to its resumed forty-first session, when it will have before it a report of the Secretary-General.

6. Calendar of conferences for 1967

At its 1442nd meeting, on 4 August 1966, the Council decided to defer until its resumed forty-first session consideration of the calendar of conferences for 1967. It will have before it a draft calendar prepared by the Secretary-General.

7. Elections

At its 1442nd meeting, on 4 August 1966, the Council decided to defer elections until its resumed forty-first session, in the light of its resolution 1147 (XLI) by which it enlarged the membership of the functional commissions and of the Committee on Housing, Building and Planning.

The Council will be required to elect members for each of the following bodies: Statistical Commission; Population Commission; Commission for Social Development; Commission on Narcotic Drugs; Commission on Human Rights; Commission on the Status of Women, and Committee on Housing, Building and Planning.

The Secretary-General will circulate a note on the subject, superseding documents E/4153 and addenda and E/4154 and addenda, which were before the Council at the fortieth session.

Under this item, the Council will also be required to elect four members of the Intergovernmental Committee of the World Food Programme for a term of office of three years, pursuant to General Assembly resolution 2095 (XX). Document E/L.1134 contains information on this subject.

In addition, the Council may wish to elect thirteen members of the Committee on Non-governmental Organizations, in accordance with rule 82 of the rules of procedure as revised by the Council in its resolution 1099 (XL).

8. Confirmation of members of functional commissions of the Council

The Secretary-General will submit to the Council for confirmation, in document E/4225 and addenda, the names of representatives of functional commissions nominated or renominated since the close of the forty-first session.

9. Basic programme of work of the Council in 1967 and consideration of the provisional agenda for the forty-second session

The Council will have before it a draft programme to be prepared by the Secretary-General as well as proposals for the disposal of items arising out of the twenty-first session of the General Assembly.

After consultation with the President of the Council, the Secretary-General proposes that the first meetings of the resumed session should take place during the week beginning on 14 November and that at those meetings the Council should take up items 1 to 8 of its agenda, leaving item 9: "Basic programme of work of the Council in 1967 and consideration of the provisional agenda for the forty-second session" for consideration at a further meeting to be held during the latter half of December when information is available regarding actions taken by the General Assembly at its twenty-first session which affect the Council's programme for 1967.
