Land violations committed in February 2022

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
1 February	1315	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite Sahl al-Khiyam, an Israeli enemy patrol composed of eight individuals, some in military clothing and some in civilian clothing, approached, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1400 hours.
	2000 2100	From inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, the Israeli enemy fired two flare shells over the Radar position.
	2309 2326	Israeli enemy personnel fired three flare shells, two of which fell in Lebanese territory, near the town of Arab al-Wazzani.
2 February	—	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 11 in Marwahin, 13 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 1 in Amra.
	0900	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Hula, at the Israeli enemy Shaykh Abbad position, a group of seven individuals in military clothing approached, scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. As they were doing so, a Hummer vehicle arrived, and the weapon mounted on the vehicle was pointed towards Lebanese territory.
	0930	As a Lebanese Army squad was inspecting and fencing minefields, an Israeli enemy soldier approached from the Bayad position in occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Blida, near points BP29 and BP29(2), and pointed his weapon towards Lebanese Army soldiers for 10 minutes. At 1010 hours, two Merkava tanks approached from the aforementioned position and took up positions behind the earthen berms. The cannon of one of those tanks was pointed towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese Army patrols until work was completed.
3 February	—	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 21 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 33 in Amra, 7 in Hula, 23 in Alma al-Sha'b, 54 in Yarun, 13 in Marwahin and 1 in Duhayrah.
	0001	From occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Aytarun, the Israeli enemy fired four flare shells, all of which fell in Lebanese territory. At 0830 hours, two Lebanese Army patrols inspected the site and found four flare-shell parachutes and remnants of the four mortar shells, which were emblazoned with words in Hebrew, that had created four craters. At 1130 hours, the breach was documented by United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon patrols that came to the site and took pictures of the shells.
5 February	1535	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite Sahl al-Khiyam, near point B90, an Israeli enemy patrol composed of approximately 15 individuals in military clothing approached, scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1600 hours.

8 February	–	Some 24 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha'b.
	1200	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite Kafr Kila, at the Jabal al-Tayyarah position, an Israeli enemy patrol composed of approximately 35 individuals in civilian clothing approached, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1250 hours.
	2250 2320	The rumble of six explosions emanated from inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, and a flare shell was fired over the Farms.
9 February	–	Some 22 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha'b.
	0715	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 10 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon four patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other six took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
10 February	–	Some 23 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha'b.
13 February	0700	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 10 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon four patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other six took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
	0900	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and points TP36 and TP36(2), four Israeli enemy civilian workers installed metal plates over the concrete wall next to the steel netting between the aforementioned points, in order to block visibility. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1150 hours.
	0930	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite point M1(1)–Ra's al-Naqrarah, three Israeli enemy personnel in civilian clothing, accompanied by an individual in military clothing, carried out welding work on the metal separation fence and used a crane to install a 2-m segment of steel netting between the concrete separation wall and the steel fence. The work was carried out in the presence of a patrol from the UNIFIL liaison unit that had come from occupied territory.
	1300	Opposite the town of Udaysah, near point TP37, Israeli enemy personnel fired, for unknown reasons, six rounds into the air towards Lebanese territory. No one was harmed in the incident.

14 February	–	Some 26 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha'b.
	0700	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 15 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon 5 patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other 10 took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
15 February	–	Some 28 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha'b and another 28 were detonated in Marwahin.
	0930	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of nine individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon five patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other four took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
16 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 26 in Alma al-Sha'b, 49 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 7 in Hula.
	1130	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite Sahl al-Khiyam, near point B90, a 15-member Israeli enemy patrol carrying maps approached and conducted a patrol along the technical fence, proceeding as far as point AP505 opposite the town of Kafr Kila, and photographed the Lebanese side. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1230 hours.
	1400	On the outskirts of the town of Hula, as Lebanese civilians were inside Lebanese territory, Israeli enemy personnel inside the enemy's Shaykh Abbad position fired one shot into the towards Lebanese territory. No one was harmed in the incident.
17 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 11 in Marwahin, 4 in Duhayrah, 8 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 21 in Hula, 33 in Amra and 12 in Markaba.
	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Duhayrah, Israeli enemy soldiers mounted a camera onto a steel tower and pointed it towards the town of Tayr Harfa.
	1300	At the Israeli enemy position east of Markaba, enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory until 1630 hours.
18 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 15 in Yarun, 19 in Marwahin, 1 in Duhayrah, 64 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 10 in Hula, 6 in Markaba and 11 in Amra.

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
	1420	An Israeli enemy foot patrol composed of 35 soldiers in military uniform approached from occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal. Twenty-four soldiers passed through the technical fence opposite point B64, and at 1430 hours, the rest of the soldiers passed through that fence opposite BP31. They proceeded to search the area, taking up combat positions and pointing their weapons towards Lebanese Army troops. Meanwhile, the cannon of a Merkava tank was pointed towards Lebanese territory. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1620 hours.
19 February	1320	An Israeli enemy foot patrol composed of 14 soldiers in military uniform approached from occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal, and passed through the metal gate in the technical fence opposite point B64. They gathered behind the earthen berms situated between the technical fence and the Blue Line, without crossing the latter, and took up combat positions, pointing their weapons towards Lebanese Army troops. At 1415 hours, a second foot patrol consisting of approximately 38 soldiers in military uniform approached from inside the enemy position east of Mays al-Jabal. They created an opening in the technical fence and passed through it opposite point BP31. Some eight of those soldiers took up combat positions, pointing their weapons at Lebanese Army soldiers, while the rest searched the area between the technical fence and the Blue Line. At 1420 hours, a patrol consisting of three GMC vehicles stopped on the technical road opposite points B64(1) and B65. Four soldiers equipped with a computer descended from the vehicles and engaged in an undetermined activity. They were accompanied by seven other soldiers and a Merkava tank, which was positioned inside the enemy position east of Mays al-Jabal. The tank's cannon was pointed towards a Lebanese Army patrol.
21 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 28 in Alma al-Sha'b, 21 in Yarun, 6 in Marwahin, 9 in Duhayrah and 17 in Amra.
22 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 30 in Alma al-Sha'b, 38 in Yarun, 22 in Marwahin, 32 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 1 in Hula, 11 in Markaba and 17 in Amra.
	0915	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 15 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon five patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other 10 took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
	1140	At the Israeli enemy's Shaykh Abbad position in occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Hula, six uniformed individuals carrying maps scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1210 hours.
	2310	The Israeli enemy fired four flare shells from occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Aytarun and points B55 and B55(1). A Lebanese Army patrol found a parachute from one of those flare shells in a plot of farmland on the outskirts of that town.

23 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 21 in Alma al-Sha‘b, 23 in Yarun, 8 in Marwahin, 27 in Hula, 18 in Amra and 16 in Markaba.
24 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 36 in Alma al-Sha‘b, 31 in Yarun, 3 in Marwahin, 15 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 2 in Hula and 50 in Amra.
	2035	Israeli enemy soldiers fired five flare shells that fell in Lebanese territory, outside the town of Duhayrah.
27 February	1405	From occupied Palestinian territory, opposite Kafr Kila, an Israeli enemy patrol composed of approximately 60 individuals in civilian clothing approached, scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1440 hours.
28 February	–	Some eight landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Marwahin and another six were detonated in Duhayrah

	1330	Off Ra’s al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for 20 minutes, proceeding on its way for some 296 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
5 February	0702	Off Ra’s al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for two minutes, proceeding on its way for some 222 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

	2030	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for 25 minutes, proceeding on its way for some 370 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
6 February	1710	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for two minutes, proceeding on its way for some 370 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	2215	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, the crew of an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for two minutes, sounded warning sirens and broadcast over loudspeakers in Hebrew.
7 February	0109	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for three minutes, proceeding on its way for some 185 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0915	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for five minutes, proceeding on its way for some 351 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
8 February	0940	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for 15 minutes, proceeding on its way for some 50 m. A Lebanese fishing boat happened to be in Lebanese territorial waters at the time. The crew broadcast in Hebrew over loudspeakers and sounded warning sirens. Both vessels left at 0955 hours, the fishing boat heading north towards Tyre and the launch heading towards occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1127	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for 13 minutes, proceeding on its way for some 463 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1822	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, the crew of an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for one minute.
13 February	0415	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for five minutes, proceeding on its way for some 222 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

	0510	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for 50 minutes, proceeding on its way for some 200 m. A Lebanese fishing boat happened to be in Lebanese territorial waters at the time. The crew fired two flare shells over Lebanese territorial waters, broadcast in Hebrew over loudspeakers and directed a searchlight towards the fishing boat. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1143	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for seven minutes, proceeding on its way for some 463 m. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	2220	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for 25 minutes, proceeding on its way for some 100 m. 	2220	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for 10 minutes, proceeding on its way for some 277 m. The crew fired a flare shell over Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
