**Identical letters dated 23 May 2022 from the Permanent
Representative of Lebanon to the United Nations addressed to the
Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council**

On instructions from the Government of Lebanon, I should like to convey to you the following information:

On 18 and 21 March 2022, the Israeli army carried out engineering work inside the occupied town of Ghajar as follows:

- On 18 March 2022, at 0800 hours, a trench digger, a civilian jeep, a wheeled bulldozer and four Israeli army personnel approached. They dug 15 holes and placed iron pipes inside them. A truck carrying basecourse also approached. It unloaded it at the location and a steamroller levelled the road. The work ended at 1615 hours.
- On 21 March 2022, at 0800 hours, an Israeli army wheeled bulldozer, two steamrollers, four trucks and a water tanker approached. They laid and levelled basecourse on the dirt road. The work ended at 1710 hours.

Lebanon considers these to be provocative and hostile acts that constitute violations of the sovereignty of Lebanon and of Security Council resolution [1701 \(2006\)](#). Lebanon calls upon you to take all necessary measures in order to deter Israel from continuing to commit serious violations of the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Lebanon.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 38, and of the Security Council.
