Financial report

I. Introduction

1. The present financial report is submitted pursuant to the request by the States parties to the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.
2. Recalling that the costs associated with the preparation and holding of the Meeting would be borne by the States parties to the Treaty and States not party to the Treaty participating therein as observers and that there would be no financial implications for the regular budget of the United Nations, States parties agreed that assessed and outstanding dues must be paid in proper time.

II. Observations

3. While most States parties have met their financial obligations, 49 States are yet to pay their assessed dues.
4. According to article 9, paragraph 1, of the Treaty, “the costs of the meetings of States Parties ... shall be borne by the States Parties and States not party to this Treaty participating therein as observers, in accordance with the United Nations scale of assessment adjusted appropriately”.

III. Financial status

5. The table below provides information, as at 8 June 2022, on the amounts owed by States parties and States not party to the Treaty participating in the Meeting as observers.
6. It should be noted that the assessed contributions for the Meeting have decreased since the original assessments were provided to States parties and observers owing to the larger number of States parties and observers that have indicated an intention to attend the Meeting.
