Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 138 are set out in the reports of the Committee contained in documents [A/76/633](#) and [A/76/633/Add.1](#).
2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 19th and 21st meetings, on 17 May and 29 June 2022. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records.¹
3. For its further consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:
 - (a) Report of the Secretary-General on addressing racism and promoting dignity for all in the United Nations Secretariat ([A/76/771](#));
 - (b) Related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions ([A/76/7/Add.39](#)).

II. Consideration of draft resolution [A/C.5/76/L.52](#)

4. At its 21st meeting, on 29 June, the Committee had before it a draft resolution entitled "Addressing racism and promoting dignity for all in the United Nations Secretariat" ([A/C.5/76/L.52](#)), submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Ghana.
5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution [A/C.5/76/L.52](#) without a vote (see para. 6).

III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Addressing racism and promoting dignity for all in the United Nations Secretariat

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,²

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General;
2. *Endorses* the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;
3. *Approves* the establishment of eight new general temporary assistance positions for 18 months, as detailed in the table below:

4. *Appropriates* an additional amount of 1,194,200 United States dollars, comprising 861,400 dollars under section 29A, Department of Management Strategy, Policy and Compliance, and 332,800 dollars under section 29B, Department of Operational Support, of the programme budget for 2022;

5. *Also appropriates* an amount of 55,700 dollars under section 36, Staff assessment, to be offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1, Income from staff assessment, of the programme budget for 2022.
