Financing of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti

Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2021, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-sixth session the item entitled “Financing of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 21st meeting, on 29 June 2022. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee’s consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record.¹
3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:
 - (a) Final performance report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti ([A/75/604](#));
 - (b) Related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions ([A/75/850](#)).

II. Consideration of draft resolution [A/C.5/76/L.50](#)

4. At its 21st meeting, on 29 June, the Committee had before it a draft resolution entitled “Financing of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti” ([A/C.5/76/L.50](#)), submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Cuba.
5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution [A/C.5/76/L.50](#) without a vote (see para. 6).

III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Financing of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the final performance of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,²

1. *Takes note* of the status of contributions to the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti as at 30 April 2022, including the contributions outstanding in the amount of 2.3 million United States dollars, representing some 0.03 per cent of the total assessed contributions, notes with concern that only 181 Member States have paid their assessed contributions in full, and urges all other Member States, in particular those in arrears, to ensure payment of their outstanding assessed contributions;

2. *Endorses* the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, and requests the Secretary-General to ensure their full implementation;

3. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General on the final performance and financing of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti;

4. *Also takes note* of the net cash available in the special account for the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti in the amount of 9,285,000 dollars as at 30 April 2022, and decides to defer action thereon until consideration of the final performance report of the United Nations Mission for Justice Support in Haiti by the General Assembly at its seventy-seventh session;

5. *Urges* all Member States to make every possible effort to ensure payment of their assessed contributions in full;

6. *Decides* to include in the provisional agenda of its seventy-seventh session the item entitled “Financing of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti”.
