COMMUNICATION FROM THE JEWISH AGENCY RELATING TO VARIOUS
ARRANGEMENTS

The following letter has been received from the Jewish
Agency, relating to various arrangements:

Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that I have arrived
in Geneva and am at the disposal of your Committee for any
additional information or expression of the views of the
Jewish Agency for Palestine which they may wish to obtain
during the present stage of their deliberations.

2. In pursuance of my oral statement before the
Committee, made at the conclusion of my last appearance,
I beg respectfully to urge, on behalf of the Jewish Agency,
that the Committee or certain members of it should visit
a few representative camps of Jewish Displaced Persons in
Germany, Austria and Italy, and some centre of post-war
Jewish life in Eastern Europe, preferably Roumania.

3. Mr. S. Adler Rudel, director of the European -
Jewish Department at the London Office of the Jewish Agency,
Mr. H. Hoffmann, head of the Jewish Agency's Relief Teams
in Germany and Austria, and Mr. Eugene Lippman, the Jewish
Agency's liaison officer with the headquarters of UNRRA
and the I.R.O., will be at the disposal of the Committee
for such assistance and guidance as may be required of them
during the proposed tours.

4. In view of the delayed arrival in Geneva of our
liaison officers with the Committee, Messrs. Eban and
Horowitz, the Executive has appointed Messrs. M. Kahany
and G. Ruffer, of our Geneva Office, to act as alternate
liaison officers. It is proposed, subject to your approval,
that Messrs. Kahany and Ruffer may discuss with your
secretariat the detailed program for the visits.
