I have the honour to confirm the following telegram
which I sent you today:

'I have received today advice inviting our Association to appear this week before your Committee in order to submit oral evidence regarding Jewish industry in Palestine stop I hasten to thank you for your sympathetic attitude towards local industry and to assure you that I would have considered it a special privilege and honour had my doctor not forbidden me travelling now to Jerusalem owing to my present state of health stop I therefore deeply regret inability to appear before stop am only too willing to forward you any additional material and explanations further to my memorandum of 3.7.47 on local industry which I had the honour to submit to you and if so desired would therefore respectfully request that specific questions be sent to me and shall then be only too eager to give all possible information at my disposal stop Allow me once again to express my deepest gratitude to you and other committee members for your attitude and interest shown to Jewish industry in Palestine both during your visit to our Association and by inviting our Association to appear before you stop Respectfully'
