**Agenda item 5: Election of the officers of the Main Committees**

1. **The Chair** said that, in accordance with rule 99 (a) of the rules of procedure, the meeting had been convened for the purpose of electing the Chair and other officers of the Bureau of the Committee for the seventy-seventh session of the General Assembly.

2. The nomination of Mr. Blanco Conde (Dominican Republic) for the post of Chair had been endorsed by the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States. In the absence of further nominations, and in accordance with rule 103 of the rules of procedure, he would take it that the Committee wished to elect Mr. Blanco Conde (Dominican Republic) Chair.

3. *Mr. Blanco Conde (Dominican Republic) was elected Chair by acclamation.*

4. **Blanco Conde** (Dominican Republic) said that he would strive to follow the example and high standards set by his predecessor in the important work on, inter alia, human rights and the empowerment of women, that were on the agenda of the Committee.

5. **The Chair** said that, in accordance with rule 103 of the rules of procedure, the nominations of Ms. Al-Thani (Qatar), Mr. Guerra (Portugal) and Ms. Kaczmarska (Poland) had been endorsed by the Group of Asia-Pacific States, the Group of Western European and Other States and the Group of Eastern European States, respectively, for the three posts of Vice-Chair, and that the nomination of Ms. Gungaram (Mauritius) for the post of Rapporteur had been endorsed by the Group of African States.

6. *Ms. Al-Thani (Qatar), Mr. Guerra (Portugal) and Ms. Kaczmarska (Poland) were elected Vice-Chairs, and Ms. Gungaram (Mauritius) was elected Rapporteur, by acclamation.*
