Letter dated 29 November 2022 from the Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council

I am writing to you in response to the identical letters dated 23 November 2022 from the representative of the Israeli regime ([S/2022/861](#)) wherein the representative attempted to conceal its destabilizing, malicious and terrorist activities in the region by resorting to lies and levelling repeated baseless accusations against my country with regard to Security Council resolution [2231\(2015\)](#).

We categorically reject all unfounded allegations and fabrications against Iran contained in the above-mentioned letter and underline that Iran has not violated resolution [2231 \(2015\)](#), nor has it threatened regional peace and stability.

The irony is that the Israeli regime, which has an abhorrent track record of developing, manufacturing and stockpiling weapons of mass destruction, has nefariously accused Iran of violating resolution [2231 \(2015\)](#), despite the fact that it, a terrorist and rogue regime, has repeatedly committed flagrant and systematic violations of the resolution over the course of several years.

It is a known fact that the Israeli regime has abused every opportunity to not only undermine and obstruct the Member States' implementation of resolution [2231 \(2015\)](#) but to also threaten and demolish the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action. That lawless regime has now accused Iran of violating the resolution, in an apparent show of hypocrisy.

The Israeli regime has also attempted to cover up the threats that its nuclear weapons pose to the region and beyond. To eliminate this threat, the international community must compel this regime to abandon nuclear weapons, join the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons and subject its nuclear activities and facilities to the International Atomic Energy Agency's comprehensive safeguards.

In fulfilling its obligations to maintain international peace and security, the Security Council must similarly compel the Israeli regime to cease all of its destabilizing and adventuristic activities in the region while holding it accountable for the flagrant and systematic violations of numerous Security Council resolutions, including resolutions [1559 \(2004\)](#), [1701 \(2006\)](#), [2254 \(2015\)](#) and [2334 \(2016\)](#).
