Amendments to article 1

Sub-paragraph (1)

Original text: "Production" means the obtaining by planting, cultivation or harvesting of natural material which constitutes a psychotropic substance or from which such a substance may readily be obtained.

Proposal by the French delegation:

- (1) "Production" means the obtaining by planting, cultivation, growing or harvesting of natural material which constitutes a psychotropic substance.

Proposal by the Algerian delegation:

- (1) "Production" means the obtaining by any means whatever of a natural or synthetic material which constitutes a psychotropic substance.

Proposal by the delegations of Australia, Belgium, India, Poland, Sweden, the United Kingdom and the United States of America and the Observer for Iraq:

Delete sub-paragraph (1)

Sub-paragraph (k)Proposal by the Australian delegation:

In the event that sub-paragraph (1) is deleted, sub-paragraph (k) will read as follows:

"Manufacture" means all processes by which psychotropic substances may be obtained including refining as well as the transformation of psychotropic substances into other psychotropic substances.
