EXAMINATION OF ANNUAL REPORTS

RUANDA URUNDI: 1948

Note by the Secretariat

1. At its fourth session, the Council accepted and examined four petitions concerning Ruanda-Urundi, which raised questions of a general character.

They were as follows:

- I. Petition from Dr. R. Van Saceghem (T/PET.3/14)
- II. Petition from Mr. Gassamunyiga Mathieu (T/PET.3/8)
- III. Petition from Mr. Francis Rukeba (T/PET.3/9)
- IV. Petition from Mr. G. Clement Ntilempaga (T/PET.3/12)

The Secretariat on that occasion prepared a working paper^{*} classifying and summarizing the general questions raised by the petitioners and the observations of the Visiting Mission thereon. The Council at that session decided to consider the general questions raised in conjunction with its examination at the fifth session of the Report concerning Ruanda-Urundi of the Visiting Mission to East Africa.^{**}

2. At its fifth session following the examination of the Report of the Visiting Mission to East Africa, the Council decided to inform the petitioners that the questions of a general character raised in their petitions had been and would be examined in connection with its examination of the annual reports of the Administering Authority on the administration of the Territory concerned.^{***}
