QUESTION OF AN INTERNATIONAL REGIME FOR THE JERUSALEM AREA AND
PROTECTION OF THE HOLY PLACES

DRAFT STATUTE FOR JERUSALEM

Philippines: Proposed Amendments to Article 31 of the Draft
Statute for Jerusalem

- (1) Replace paragraph 1 by the following wording of Article 26 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights:

1. Everyone has the right to education.
Education shall be free, at least in the elementary and fundamental stages. Elementary education shall be compulsory. Technical and professional education shall be made generally available and higher education shall be equally accessible to all on the basis of merit.

2. Education shall be directed to the full development of the human personality and to the strengthening of respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms. It shall promote understanding, tolerance and friendship among all nations, racial or religious groups, and shall further the activities of the United Nations for the maintenance of peace.

- (2) Add a new paragraph after the existing paragraph 3 of Article 31 as follows:

"Parents shall be free to choose the kind of education, including religious instruction, that shall be given to their children."
