POLITICAL, ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND EDUCATIONAL ADVANCEMENT  
IN TRUST TERRITORIES

Argentina and Philippines: Amendment to the Draft Resolution presented  
by Iraq and the United States of America. (T/L.7)

To replace paragraphs 1 to 5 of the operative part of document T/L.7  
by the following:

The Trusteeship Council

Resolves to give effect to the recommendations of the General  
Assembly contained in the aforesaid resolutions;

Notes that steps have already been taken or are being taken by  
the Council to carry out some of the provisions of these recommendations;

Decides:

A - with regard to Economic Advancement:

1) to recommend to the Administering Authorities concerned to take  
measures to assure to the Trust Territories under their administration budgetary  
autonomy and to provide the Trusteeship Council with adequate information with  
a view to enable the Council to make a thorough examination of the financial  
situation of the Trust Territories;

B - with regard to Social Advancement:

1) to recommend to the Administering Authorities concerned the abolition  
of the corporal punishment of whipping in all Trust Territories and the immediate  
initiation of strong and effective measures to this effect;

2) to establish a Committee composed of six Members to make a preliminary  
study of all laws, statutes and ordinances, as well as their application,

in the Trust Territories in order to enable the Council to make positive recommendations to the Administering Authorities concerned with a view to the abolition of all discriminatory provisions and practices contrary to the principles of the Charter and the Trusteeship Agreements. The Committee shall meet between the 6th and 7th Session of the Council and present an interim report not later than July 1;

3) to invite the Administering Authority concerned to cooperate with the Committee and to furnish to it all information it may require;

4) to request the Secretariat, with the cooperation of the International Labour Organisation, to submit to the next session of the Council such information as may be available on the social problems of migrant labour and penal sanctions for breach of labour contracts by indigenous inhabitants in Trust Territories.

C - With regard to Educational Advancement:

1) to request the Administering Authorities to study the possibility of including in the curricula of schools in the Trust Territories instructions on the United Nations, the International Trusteeship System and the special status of Trust Territories, and to this end, to make use, if they so desire, of the cooperation that may be furnished by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization;

2) to call on the Administering Authorities concerned to intensify the measures they have taken, and to take as soon as possible the necessary measures, if not already taken, for the establishment in Africa of educational institutions of university standard and systems of scholarships allowing indigenous students to complete their university training in other countries;

3) to request the Administering Authorities to include in their next Annual Reports information dealing specifically with the implementation of the recommendations contained in the two previous paragraphs and in the Resolutions 36 (III), 83 (IV) and 110 (V) of the Trusteeship Council.

D - with respect to Visiting Missions:

1) to recommend to all Visiting Missions to report fully on the steps taken towards the realisation of the objectives set forth in Article 76 (b) of the Charter under the headings of political, economic, social and educational advancement, and in particular on the steps taken toward self-government or independence.
