Land violations committed in June 2023

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
1 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 9 in Yarun, 5 in Hula and 20 in Amrah.
	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
2 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 11 in Yarun, 10 in Naqurah, 9 in Hula, 15 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 11 in Amrah.
4 June	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Shuba, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory.
	1430	On the outskirts of the town of Shab'a, while the herder Yusuf Zahrah was herding livestock, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of eight soldiers approached from occupied territory. They tried to abduct him, but were unsuccessful. He fled towards the town of Shab'a
	1635	At the junction of the towns of Marwahin, Tarbikha and Ramiya, opposite point M4, while several Lebanese civilians were present inside Lebanese territory, an Israeli enemy foot patrol approach from occupied territory. Its members threw three percussion bombs that landed inside occupied territory. They also fired several shots in the direction of Lebanese territory over the heads of the civilians. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1700 hours.
5 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 22 in Yarun, 7 in Naqurah, 10 in Balida and 9 in Amrah.
	0815	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Shuba, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannons of two Merkava tanks towards Lebanese territory.
	2145	In the occupied Shab'a Farms, Israeli enemy personnel fired two flare shells in the area around the enemy Radar position.
6 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 9 in Naqurah, 10 in Balida, 4 in Hula and 25 in Amrah.
	0815	In occupied Lebanese territory on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba at Birkat Ba'tha'il, the Israeli enemy completed bulldozing work using two Poclain excavators and a wheeled excavator. A barbed wire strip was laid at the excavation site extending some 200 m towards the enemy Summaqah position,

		with the help of 10 personnel in military uniform escorted by five Merkava tanks pointing their cannons towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army soldiers. One of the excavators violated the withdrawal line (the Blue Line with respect to which Lebanon maintains reservations) by approximately 15 m next to the concrete blocks without carrying out any work. This happened in the presence of United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) liaison unit personnel, who tried to get it to go back south of the line. The work ended at 1550 hours, and the vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.
	0930	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Kila, at the Israeli enemy Jabal al-Tayyarah position, an enemy group of 50 individuals in civilian clothing approached. They scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1200 hours.
7 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 10 in Yarun, 13 in Naqurah, 13 in Balida, 37 in Hula and 94 in Amrah.
	0845	In occupied Lebanese territory on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba, the Israeli enemy completed bulldozing work with a D9 bulldozer escorted by 20 soldiers who took up combat positions. They pointed their weapons and the cannons of two Merkava tanks towards civilians, Lebanese army personnel and UNIFIL personnel after a number of civilians and herders gathered to protest Israeli enemy activity. Civilian Isma'il Nasir stood in front of the bulldozer to stop it from completing the road construction, but it swept him away. UNIFIL personnel and civilians intervened to pulled him out from the ground. At 1550 hours, the enemy personnel and their vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.
8 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 7 in Yarun and 2 in Hula.
	0815	In occupied Lebanese territory on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba at Birkat Ba'tha'il, the Israeli enemy completed bulldozing work with two Poclain bulldozers escorted by two Defender vehicles, two Wrangler vehicle, a Merkava tank, and 20 enemy soldiers who took up combat positions and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory. The bulldozer started to move concrete blocks from the Hasan Gate to the area where the work was being done. Some 15 enemy soldiers laid a barbed wire strip extending some 300 m towards the enemy Summaqah position with the help of 10 personnel in military uniform, escorted by five Merkava tanks with their cannons pointed towards Lebanese territory. The work ended at 1500 hours, and the vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.
9 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 2 in Yarun, 5 in Naqurah, 9 in Balida, 28 in Hula, 10 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 27 in Amrah.
	1100	A number of civilians gathered to protest Israeli enemy activity in occupied Lebanese territory on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba. An Israeli enemy patrol consisting of a Merkava tank, two Wrangler vehicles and two Humvee vehicles approached from occupied territory. Some 20 personnel in military uniform disembarked and threw tear gas bombs directly at the civilians, causing some of them to suffocate and injuring a Lebanese army soldier in his hand. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1515 hours.

11 June	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
	0830	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Sarda, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed a Humvee-mounted machine gun towards Lebanese territory.
	1415	A number of civilians gathered to protest enemy activity in occupied Lebanese territory on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba. Israeli enemy soldiers threw two smoke bombs, one of which landed inside Lebanese territory and one of which landed inside occupied Lebanese territory. At 1530 hours, enemy soldiers threw nine smoke bombs, six of which landed inside Lebanese territory and three of which landed inside occupied Lebanese territory. At 1600 hours, Israeli enemy soldiers threw 46 smoke bombs that landed inside Lebanese territory.
12 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 9 in Yarun, 6 in Naqurah and 10 in Balida.
	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
13 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 7 in Yarun, 8 in Naqurah, 9 in Balida, 14 in Hula, 25 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 46 in Amrah.
	0830	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
14 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 7 in Naqurah, 13 in Balida, 14 in Hula and 76 in Amrah.
15 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 3 in Yarun, 6 in Naqurah, 18 in Balida, 5 in Hula, 20 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 48 in Amrah.
	0745	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP35, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
16 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 12 in Yarun, 6 in Naqurah, 18 in Balida, 12 in Hula and 50 in Amrah.
17 June	1530	On the outskirts of the town of Shab'a, while herder As'ad Hamdan was herding livestock, a Israeli enemy foot patrol consisting of 12 soldiers approached from occupied territory. They tried to abduct him, but were unsuccessful. He fled towards the town of Shab'a. The soldiers seized the herd and led it towards occupied territory. At 1530 hours, the enemy soldiers released the herd at the same location and the herder took it back.
18 June	1800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.

19 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 8 in Naqurah, 8 in Marun al-Ra's, 7 in Balida and 54 in Amrah.
	0830	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
20 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 22 in Yarun, 17 in Hula, 25 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 50 in Amrah, 14 in Balida, 9 in Naqurah and 9 in Marun al-Ra's.
	0830	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
21 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 6 in Naqurah, 5 in Marun al-Ra's, 8 in Balida, 8 in Yarun, 8 in Hula, 20 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 62 in Amrah.
	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Rumaysh at points B33(3) and B34(1), an enemy Israeli patrol consisting of an excavator, a shovel bulldozer, a gravel spreader, two Defender vehicles and three civilian cars approached. Five personnel in military uniform disembarked. The bulldozer smoothed and cleaned the technical road. The excavator cleared brush outside the technical fence with its arm. On 22 June 2023 at 0800 hours, a Lebanese Army topographic team arrived on the scene to inspect the bulldozing and brush-clearing activity from the previous day. It was determined that there had been nine violations of the withdrawal line (the Blue Line) extending varying distances inside Lebanese territory.
	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
		In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
	0850	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Kila, at the Israeli enemy Jabal al-Tayyarah position, an enemy group of 40 individuals in civilian clothing approached. They scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1200 hours.
22 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 7 in Naqurah, 4 in Marun al-Ra's, 8 in Balida, 18 in Hula, 23 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 43 in Amrah.
	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya, opposite points B28 and BP10/1, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
23 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 9 in Naqurah, 4 in Marun al-Ra's, 8 in Balida, 15 in Hula, 2 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 5 in Amrah and 16 in Yarun.

	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Hula near point TP33(1), Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and Lebanese army patrols.
29 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 9 in Naqurah, 1 in Marun al-Ra's and 17 in Balida.
30 June	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 8 in Naqurah and 8 in Marun al-Ra's.
