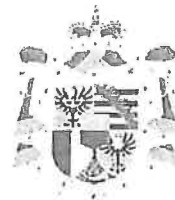

The Government of Saint Lucia and the Government of the Principality of Liechtenstein,
Desirous to promote and strengthen the bonds of friendship and cooperation between
the two countries,

Guided by the principles and purposes enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations and
the provisions of International Law, particularly on the respect for the promotion of
international peace and security, equality among States, national sovereignty,
international treaties, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States.

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations in accordance with the provisions of the
Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 and the Vienna Convention on
Consular Relations of 24 April 1963 as of the date of signing of this Joint Communiqué.
