## Confirmation of the appointment of members of the Investments Committee

### Note by the Secretary-General

1. As indicated in document [A/78/103](#), the General Assembly will be required, at its current session, to confirm the appointment by the Secretary-General of five persons to fill five existing vacancies in the Investments Committee.
2. In accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the Regulations, Rules and Pension Adjustment System of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary-General, after consultation with the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, submits for confirmation by the General Assembly the reappointment of Yasir O. Al-Rumayyan (Saudi Arabia), Sarah Omotunde Alade (Nigeria), Natalia Khanjenkova (Russian Federation) and Patricia Parise (Argentina) as regular members of the Investments Committee for a three-year term of office each beginning on 1 January 2024.
3. In addition, it will be necessary for the General Assembly to confirm the appointment of Shan Li (China) as a regular member of the Investments Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2024.
4. In accordance with past practice, the Secretary-General submits for confirmation by the General Assembly the reappointment of Macky Tall (Mali) as an ad hoc member for a one-year term of office, beginning on 1 January 2024.
