CONDITIONS IN THE TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS

Union of Soviet Socialist Republics: draft resolution

The Trusteeship Council,

Having examined the annual report of the United States of America for 1962-1963 on the administration of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands,

Having heard the statements of the representatives of the Administering Authority regarding the situation in the Trust Territory,

Having examined the report of the 1964 Visiting Mission to the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (T/1620),

Having been informed by the Administering Authority that plans are under consideration for establishing a legislative body of the Trust Territory, namely, the Congress of Micronesia,

Noting that since its approval on 2 April 1947 of the Trusteeship Agreement concerning the Territory of the Pacific Islands, the Security Council has not examined the question of conditions in the Trust Territory,

Recommends the Security Council to examine the question of conditions in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands before the nineteenth session of the United Nations General Assembly.
