Carta de fecha 27 de agosto de 2024 dirigida al Secretario General por la Representante Permanente de Chipre ante las Naciones Unidas

Siguiendo instrucciones de mi Gobierno, transmito de forma adjunta a la presente carta 32 anexos separados en los que se detallan los casos en que las fuerzas aéreas y navales de Türkiye han violado el espacio aéreo nacional de Chipre, las normas internacionales de tráfico aéreo en la región de información de vuelo de Chipre y las aguas territoriales de Chipre, además de usar ilegalmente los puertos y aeropuertos clausurados de Chipre desde marzo de 2023 hasta junio de 2024.

En total, durante ese período se observaron 2.120 violaciones del espacio aéreo y 137 de las aguas territoriales. Cabe señalar que 639 de las 2.120 violaciones del espacio aéreo estuvieron relacionadas con el uso de vehículos aéreos no tripulados turcos. Además, Türkiye realizó maniobras militares que violaron el espacio aéreo de la República de Chipre, por lo que emitió ilegalmente 12 avisos a los aviadores y 2 textos de navegación.

Las constantes violaciones del *statu quo* militar en la isla y los avances casi diarios hacia la zona de amortiguación, agravados por la continua mejora de la infraestructura militar en las zonas ocupadas, ya densamente militarizadas, constituyen solo un fragmento del comportamiento persistentemente agresivo de Türkiye en Chipre. Los numerosos casos de violaciones o movimientos militares por parte de las fuerzas de ocupación turcas pretenden crear nuevos hechos consumados y socavar tanto la sensación de seguridad de la población como los esfuerzos para la reanudación de las negociaciones. Estas acciones revelan las intenciones de Ankara de perpetuar su ocupación y entrañan graves riesgos no solo para la seguridad, la soberanía y la integridad territorial de Chipre, sino también para la seguridad y la estabilidad de toda la región del Mediterráneo Oriental.

Este año se cumplen 50 años de la continua ocupación ilegal turca en Chipre. Esta violación de la soberanía y la integridad territorial de la República de Chipre y las trágicas consecuencias que ha creado para nuestra isla y su pueblo constituyen el núcleo del inaceptable e insostenible *statu quo* actual que estamos llamados a superar. Por el contrario, como invasor y fuerza ocupante en Chipre, Türkiye está intensificando sus esfuerzos para imponer una “solución biestatal” en la isla. Türkiye utiliza un enfoque a la carta en lo que respecta a las resoluciones del Consejo de Seguridad, y, cuando no se ajustan a su discurso, opta por tacharlas de obsoletas y exhorta a la comunidad



internacional a que “afronte las realidades sobre el terreno”, en un intento de convencerla de que el resultado de su agresión tiene un efecto jurídico válido.

Las acciones y la retórica agresivas de Türkiye son un factor desestabilizador tanto sobre el terreno en Chipre como en la región en general. La continua violación de la integridad territorial y la soberanía de Chipre, y por consiguiente de la Carta de las Naciones Unidas, demuestra el flagrante desprecio de Türkiye por el derecho internacional. Esto es particularmente evidente en el caso de Varosha, donde a pesar del claro llamamiento del Consejo de Seguridad (véase [S/PRST/2021/13](#)) a la parte turca para que detenga y revierta las violaciones del *statu quo*, la transformación ilegal de la zona cercada continúa en forma incesante, haciendo caso omiso de la resolución [550 \(1984\)](#) del Consejo de Seguridad, en la que el Consejo pide que Varosha sea devuelta a sus legítimos habitantes y que la zona se transfiera a la administración de las Naciones Unidas.

En el contexto geopolítico actual, es imperioso que las Naciones Unidas demuestren que no hay dobles raseros en la aplicación de la Carta. Se debe defender la soberanía y la integridad territorial de los Estados atacados, sin importar de dónde procedan los ataques ni cuánto tiempo haya transcurrido. Indudablemente esto es válido en el caso de Chipre, donde el problema sigue siendo una invasión militar y una ocupación ilegal que aún continúa. La situación que Türkiye ha creado en Chipre mediante el uso de la fuerza y las incesantes violaciones de los derechos humanos y de la legalidad internacional son el verdadero rostro de las “realidades sobre el terreno”: las violaciones de la Carta y de las resoluciones del Consejo de Seguridad se han convertido en la norma. Ese es precisamente el motivo por el que el Consejo de Seguridad debe hacer valer sus resoluciones y asegurarse de que tengan un significado; de lo contrario, la credibilidad del sistema internacional se verá gravemente socavada.

Estamos atravesando un período especialmente delicado y difícil. El nombramiento el pasado mes de enero de María Angela Holguín Cuéllar como su Enviada Personal fue un acontecimiento bienvenido y largamente esperado que proporcionó un ímpetu renovado al esfuerzo por lograr la reanudación de las negociaciones. Desgraciadamente, hasta ahora este esfuerzo sigue viéndose socavado por la insistencia de la parte turca en posiciones que se sitúan directamente fuera de los parámetros establecidos por las Naciones Unidas respecto a la solución del problema de Chipre. Al mismo tiempo, esta postura inaceptable se manifiesta cada vez más en acciones provocadoras sobre el terreno en Chipre, así como a través de la intensificación de los esfuerzos en pos de la legitimización internacional de la entidad secesionista.

A pesar de los escollos interpuestos por Türkiye y su administración local subordinada, la República de Chipre sigue comprometida con la solución refrendada por las Naciones Unidas para la solución del problema de Chipre como una federación bizonal y bicomunal con igualdad política, como se establece en las resoluciones del Consejo de Seguridad. Este marco acordado constituye el único camino viable para avanzar en el esfuerzo por resolver el problema de Chipre y, en este sentido, el Gobierno de la República de Chipre tiene la intención de desplegar todos los esfuerzos posibles, en cooperación con usted, para crear las condiciones que permitan reanudar las negociaciones, con el objetivo de reunificar Chipre y su pueblo, sobre la base de las resoluciones pertinentes del Consejo de Seguridad.

Le agradecería que tuviera a bien hacer distribuir la presente carta y sus anexos como documento oficial de la Asamblea General, en relación con el tema 40 del programa, y del Consejo de Seguridad.
