**Lettre datée du 27 août 2024, adressée au Secrétaire général
par la Représentante permanente de Chypre auprès de
l'Organisation des Nations Unies**

D'ordre de mon gouvernement, j'ai l'honneur de vous faire tenir ci-joint, dans 32 annexes distinctes, la liste des violations de l'espace aérien et des eaux territoriales de Chypre ainsi que de la réglementation internationale de la circulation aérienne dans la région d'information de vol de Chypre commises par les forces navales et aériennes de la Türkiye et celle des cas d'utilisation illégale par ce pays de ports et d'aéroports chypriotes fermés, pour la période de mars 2023 à juin 2024.

Au total, 2 120 violations de l'espace aérien de Chypre et 137 violations de son espace maritime ont été observées au cours de la période susmentionnée. Il convient de noter que 639 des 2 120 violations de l'espace aérien étaient liées à l'utilisation de drones militaires turcs. En outre, la Türkiye a effectué des exercices militaires lors desquels elle a violé l'espace aérien de la République de Chypre, pour lesquels elle a émis illégalement 12 avis aux navigateurs aériens et 2 messages texte pour la navigation.

Les violations constantes du statu quo militaire sur l'île et les incursions quasi quotidiennes dans la zone tampon, auxquelles s'ajoute le renforcement continu de l'infrastructure militaire dans les zones occupées qui sont déjà fortement militarisées, ne constituent que quelques exemples illustrant le comportement agressif que la Türkiye continue d'afficher vis-à-vis de Chypre. L'objectif des nombreuses violations militaires et incursions commises par les forces d'occupation turques est de créer de nouveaux « faits accomplis », ainsi que d'affaiblir le sentiment de sécurité au sein de la population et de nuire aux efforts faits en vue d'une reprise des négociations. Ce comportement montre qu'Ankara entend perpétuer son occupation et entraîne des risques graves non seulement pour la sécurité, la souveraineté et l'intégrité territoriale de Chypre, mais aussi pour la sécurité et la stabilité de l'ensemble de la région de la Méditerranée orientale.

Cette année marque 50 ans d'occupation illégale de Chypre par la Türkiye. Cette violation de la souveraineté et de l'intégrité territoriale de la République de Chypre et les conséquences tragiques qu'elle a entraînées pour notre île et son peuple sont au cœur du statu quo inacceptable actuel, qui ne saurait durer et dont on nous engage à sortir. La Türkiye, en tant que pays envahisseur et force d'occupation à Chypre, redouble d'efforts pour imposer une « solution à deux États » à l'île. Adoptant une



approche « à la carte » des résolutions du Conseil de sécurité, elle choisit de qualifier celles-ci d'obsolètes lorsqu'elles ne cadrent pas avec son discours et demande à la communauté internationale de « regarder en face les réalités sur le terrain », dans une tentative de faire croire que son agression produit un effet juridique valable.

Les agissements et la rhétorique agressifs de la Türkiye sont un facteur de déstabilisation tant sur le terrain à Chypre que dans l'ensemble de la région. Le fait que la Türkiye continue de violer l'intégrité territoriale et la souveraineté de Chypre et, par conséquent, la Charte des Nations Unies illustre le mépris flagrant de ce pays pour le droit international. Cette réalité est particulièrement évidente dans le cas de Varosha, où la transformation illégale de la zone clôturée se poursuit sans relâche, en dépit du fait que le Conseil de sécurité a explicitement demandé à la partie turque (voir document [S/PRST/2021/13](#)) de mettre fin aux violations du statu quo et de revenir sur les mesures qu'elle a prises à cet égard, et au mépris total de la résolution [550 \(1984\)](#) du Conseil, dans laquelle celui-ci a demandé que Varosha soit restituée à ses habitants légitimes et le secteur placé sous l'administration de l'ONU.

Dans le contexte géopolitique mondial actuel, il est impératif que l'ONU démontre qu'il n'y a pas deux poids, deux mesures dans l'application de la Charte. La souveraineté et l'intégrité territoriale des États que l'on attaque doivent être défendues, quelle que soit la provenance des attaques et quel que soit le temps écoulé. C'est certainement vrai dans le cas de Chypre, où le problème demeure celui d'une invasion militaire et d'une occupation illégale qui se poursuit. Les « réalités sur le terrain » sont en fait le résultat de la situation que la Türkiye a créée à Chypre en employant la force et en violant sans cesse les droits humains et la légalité internationale ; les violations de la Charte et des résolutions du Conseil de sécurité y sont devenues la norme. C'est précisément la raison pour laquelle le Conseil de sécurité doit défendre ses propres résolutions et s'assurer qu'elles ne restent pas lettre morte, sans quoi la crédibilité du système international est en péril.

Nous traversons actuellement une période particulièrement sensible et difficile. La nomination, en janvier dernier, de María Angela Holguín Cuéllar au poste d'Envoyée personnelle a marqué une évolution positive et attendue depuis longtemps, et donné un nouvel élan aux efforts déployés pour faire reprendre les négociations. Malheureusement, le comportement de la partie turque, qui campe sur des positions ne respectant clairement pas les paramètres définis par l'ONU pour régler la question de Chypre, continue jusqu'à présent d'entraver son travail. Dans le même temps, la multiplication des actes provocateurs commis sur le terrain à Chypre et l'intensification des efforts visant à favoriser la revalorisation internationale de l'entité sécessionniste illustrent de plus en plus clairement la position inacceptable de la Türkiye.

Malgré les pierres d'achoppement que la Türkiye et l'administration locale qui lui est inféodée placent devant elle, la République de Chypre reste attachée à un règlement de la question de Chypre s'appuyant sur les propositions de l'ONU telles qu'elles figurent dans les résolutions du Conseil de sécurité, fondé sur une fédération bizonale et bicommunautaire et sur l'égalité politique. Ce cadre convenu est la seule voie viable pour régler la question de Chypre ; dans cette optique, le Gouvernement de la République de Chypre a l'intention de faire tout ce qui est en son pouvoir, en coopération avec vous, pour créer les conditions nécessaires à une reprise des négociations, dans le but de réunifier Chypre et son peuple, sur la base des résolutions pertinentes du Conseil.

Je vous serais reconnaissante de bien vouloir faire distribuer le texte de la présente lettre et de ses annexes comme document de l'Assemblée générale, au titre du point 40 de l'ordre du jour, et du Conseil de sécurité.
