## **Letter dated 4 September 2024 from the Permanent Representative of Ukraine to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General**

I write to inform you of Russia's continued terrorist attacks that deliberately target civilians and civilian infrastructure in Ukraine, including but not limited to the cases listed below. Photographs are transmitted, as well as links to further footage (see annex).\*

On Wednesday, 4 September 2024, Russia targeted civilians and civilian infrastructure in Lviv. As a result of the attack, at least 7 civilians were killed, including 2 children, and at least 64 others were injured, including 8 children. Among the victims was an entire family (see annex), among whom only the father survived – Russia killed his wife and three daughters – Emilia, 7, Daryna, 18, and Yaryna, 21. In total, 156 buildings in Lviv, including 3 schools and 2 medical institutions, were damaged by the Russian Federation.

In Kryvyi Rih, Dnipropetrovsk region, at least six people, including a 10-year-old girl, were injured as a result of Russia's shelling of the city centre. The Russian attacks also damaged multiple apartment buildings, five educational institutions, eight stores and a pharmacy in the city.

Given the persistent and ongoing nature of these attacks, and recognizing the urgent need for immediate intervention, I would appreciate your personal attention and the full utilization of all available instruments within the mandates of the relevant United Nations agencies to address these continued crimes by the Russian Federation against Ukraine's civilian population and infrastructure.

The crime of aggression, war crimes and crimes against humanity committed by the Russian Federation further underscore Russia's non-compliance with the United Nations membership criteria set out in Article 4 of the Charter of the United Nations, as well as the inadmissibility of inaction regarding Russia's illegitimate presence in the Security Council.

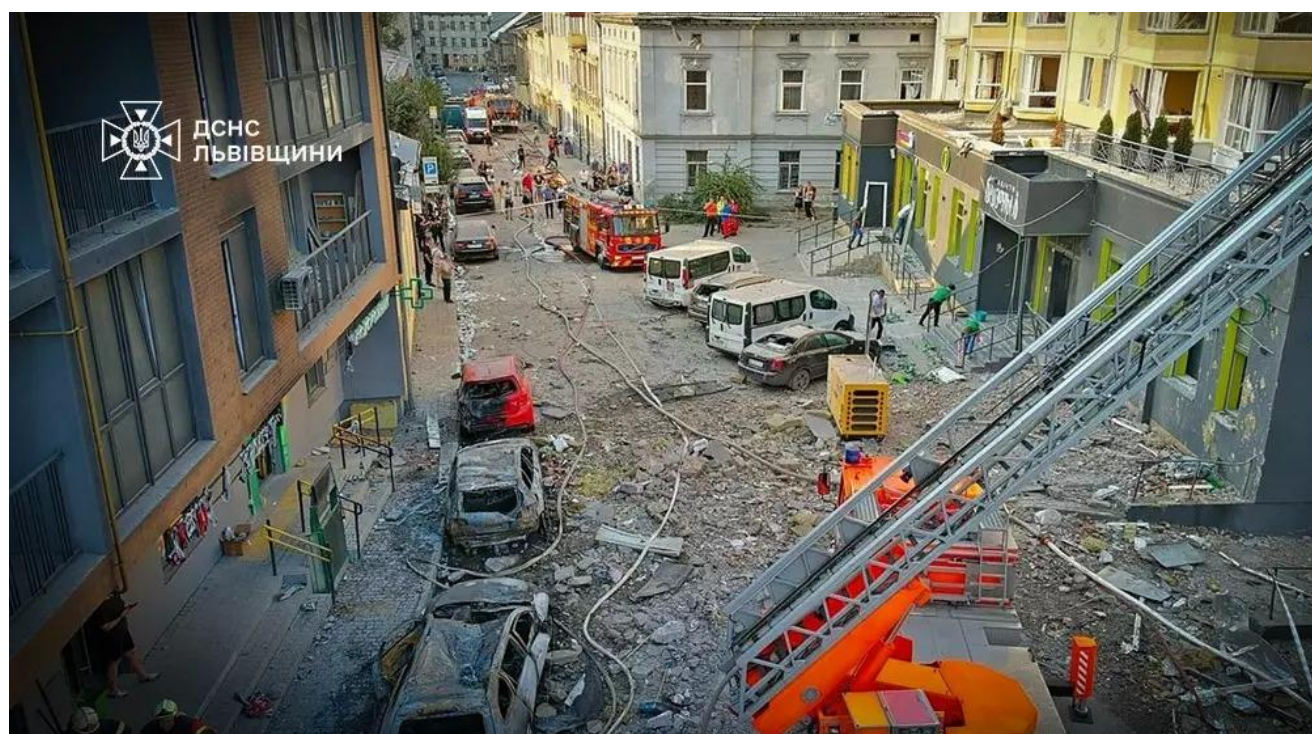
