The possibility of redefining or supplementing
the Commission's terms of reference

The suggestions mentioned below should be regarded as elements of a possible understanding on the further examination and redefining or supplementing the Commission's terms of reference with a view to ensuring the effective enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms.

Terms of reference of the Commission on Human Rights should be redefined and supplemented by inserting the provisions of paragraph 1 of General Assembly resolution 32/130. In particular an emphasis should be made on:

(a) Interdependence of human rights, development, peace and disarmament; measures favouring the establishment of a new international economic order should be priority issues.

(b) Measures and recommendations concerning the encouragement of the efforts directed towards the strengthening of peace, security and equity in international life as a vital condition for the full realization of human rights and fundamental freedoms.
