APPLICATION OF ROUMANIA FOR ADMISSION TO
MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 12 October 1948, from the Minister for
Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of
Roumania to the Secretary-General

Note by the Secretary-General: Pursuant to rule 124 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit herewith for the information of the Members of the General Assembly a copy of a letter, dated 12 October 1948, from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of Roumania, concerning the application of Roumania for admission to membership in the United Nations.

Bucharest, 12 October 1948

The Government of the People's Republic of Roumania, in accordance with the provisions of Article 4 of the United Nations Charter and recalling the application for admission to the United Nations made on 10 July 1947 and the requests for further examination thereof made on 22 September 1947 by the Polish Minister of Foreign Affairs and on 5 April 1948 by the representative of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, has the honour to renew the application of the People's Republic of Roumania for admission to membership in the United Nations.

The Government of the People's Republic of Roumania declares its acceptance of all the obligations incumbent upon Members of the United Nations under the Charter.

The Government of the People's Republic of Roumania, referring to the agenda of the third session of the General Assembly of the United Nations and to the fact that among the items on the said agenda is the admission of new Members, requests you to submit the present application to the General Assembly and, to that end, to include it in its agenda.
