Report of the Fifth Committee

1. In accordance with the instructions of the General Assembly on 3 November 1948, the Fifth Committee, at its 160th meeting on 15 November 1948, considered the question of filling the vacancy in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions which had occurred because of the resignation of Mr. Donald C. Stone.
2. Prior to 15 November, the Chairman had called for nominations from members of a person to be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to the Advisory Committee. At the time when the question was considered by the Fifth Committee, one nomination had been received.
3. In accordance with the rules of procedure of the General Assembly the vote was taken by secret ballot, with the following result:
