QUESTION OF THE DISPOSAL OF THE FORMER ITALIAN COLONIES

Pakistan: Draft Resolution

Whereas, in pursuance of Article 23 and Annex XI of the Treaty of Peace with Italy signed at Paris on 10 February 1947, France, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom, and the United States of America have referred to the General Assembly of the United Nations for decision the question of the disposal of the former Italian colonies,

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

Decides to establish a Special Committee consisting of seven members to be appointed by the President of the General Assembly which shall examine the question and prepare a report thereon for the consideration of the General Assembly,

Empowers the Special Committee to ascertain all the relevant facts, including written or oral testimony from the present administering authorities, from representatives of the populations of the territories, from Governments and from such organizations and individuals as it may deem necessary,

Authorizes the Special Committee to conduct its investigations wherever it considers necessary,

Requests the Special Committee to submit its report, and such proposals as it may consider appropriate, to the Secretary-General not later than 1 September 1949.
