Provisional agenda and dates for the thirty-second session of the Commission**Proposals for a multi-year programme of work****Note by the Secretariat**

1. In its resolution 1999/51 on the restructuring and revitalization of the United Nations in the economic, social and related fields, the Economic and Social Council requested the functional commissions to adopt a multi-year programme of work. The annex to the present note contains the actual agenda items for 2000 and proposed agendas for 2001-2003, in abbreviated form, which constitute a multi-year programme of work (the items listed for 2001 coincide with the items listed in document E/CN.3/2000/L.3/Rev.1 but may need to be adjusted in the light of decisions that the Commission will make when it considers that document; this may also lead to some modifications to the proposals for 2002 and 2003).

2. The multi-year programme of work is proposed to be implemented along the lines set out by the ad hoc group established by the Statistical Commission to explore new approaches to its structure and operation (see E/CN.3/1999/23, in particular para. 13) and adopted by the Commission at its thirtieth session. The ad hoc group identified various roles for preparation of Commission documents, in particular the role of "programme reviewer"; the ad hoc group considered that countries should act in that capacity. The Commission may wish to select one or two agenda items for 2001 and try to implement the recommendations of the ad hoc group on an experimental basis.
