The Fifth Committee decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/55/L.62/Rev.1, a total additional appropriation of \$6,315,600, comprising the requirements of \$6,001,500 for 2001 and the additional requirements of \$314,100 for 2000, would be required under section 3, Political affairs, of the programme budget for the biennium 2000-2001.
