Organizational matters

A. Opening and duration of the session

1. The Commission for Social Development acting as preparatory committee for the Second World Assembly on Ageing held its first session at United Nations Headquarters from 26 February to 2 March 2001. The committee held ____ meetings (1st to ____) and a number of informal meetings.

2. The Chairman of the Commission for Social Development, Faith Innerarity (Jamaica), opened the session and made a statement.

3. At the 1st meeting, on 26 February, the Director of the Division for Social Policy and Development made an introductory statement.

B. Attendance

4. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 54/262 of 25 May 2000, the committee was open to the

participation of all States Members of the United Nations, members of the specialized agencies and observers, in accordance with the established practice of the General Assembly.

5. The following States were represented at the session: Argentina, Austria, Chile, Costa Rica, Croatia, Dominican Republic, Germany, Guatemala, Holy See, India, Jamaica, Mauritius, Morocco, Mozambique, Myanmar, Namibia, Netherlands, Portugal, Qatar, Russian Federation, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Sweden, Syrian Arab Republic, Thailand, Ukraine, United States of America, Uruguay and Zambia.

6. The following United Nations fund was represented: United Nations Population Fund.

7. The following specialized agencies were represented: International Labour Organization and World Health Organization.

8. The following intergovernmental organization was represented by an observer: International Federation of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies.



9. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 54/262, non-governmental organizations in the field of ageing also attended the session.
