Report of the Secretary-General on the work of the Organization

Draft resolution submitted by the President of the General Assembly

Prevention of armed conflict

The General Assembly,

Having received the report of the Secretary-General entitled “Prevention of armed conflict”¹ and the recommendations contained therein,

Recalling its debate on the report on 12 and 13 July 2001,

1. *Calls upon* Governments to consider the report and the recommendations therein;
2. *Calls upon* regional and subregional organizations to consider the report and the recommendations addressed to them therein;
3. *Calls upon* all relevant organs, organizations and bodies of the United Nations system to consider, in accordance with their mandates, the recommendations addressed to them and to inform the General Assembly, preferably during the fifty-sixth session, of their views in this regard;
4. *Invites* relevant civil society actors to consider the report and the recommendations addressed to them therein;
5. *Decides* to continue to consider the report and the recommendations therein at its fifty-sixth session, taking into account, as appropriate, any views and comments received pursuant to paragraphs 1 to 4 above.
