Draft resolution submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations

Management of buildings: practices of selected United Nations system organizations relevant to the renovation of the United Nations Headquarters

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Joint Inspection Unit entitled “Management of buildings: practices of selected United Nations system organizations relevant to the renovation of the United Nations Headquarters”¹ and the comments of the Secretary-General thereon,²

1. *Welcomes* the comprehensive and timely preparation of the report of the Joint Inspection Unit;¹

2. *Endorses* the report of the Joint Inspection Unit¹ and requests the Secretary-General to take full account of its recommendations and findings when elaborating the capital master plan, without prejudice to the future consideration by the General Assembly of the report of the Secretary-General on the capital master plan;

3. *Decides* to revert to the consideration of the report of the Joint Inspection Unit¹ and the comments of the Secretary-General thereon² within the context of its consideration of the report of the Secretary-General on the capital master plan requested by the General Assembly in section IV of its resolution 55/238 of 23 December 2000.
