Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2001, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-sixth session the item entitled "Report of the Economic and Social Council" and to allocate chapters I, VII (sections B and C) and IX of the report of the Council¹ to the Fifth Committee.
2. The Fifth Committee considered at its 31st meeting, on 3 December 2001, the chapters of the report of the Economic and Social Council that had been allocated to it. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/56/SR.31).
3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, without objection, to recommend to the General Assembly that it take note of the chapters of the report of the Economic and Social Council that had been allocated to the Fifth Committee (see para. 4).
