Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2001/15 of 19 March 2001, S/2001/15/Add.3 of 28 March 2001, S/2001/15/Add.5 of 2 April 2001, S/2001/15/Add.6 of 4 April 2001, S/2001/15/Add.7 of 6 April 2001, S/2001/15/Add.10 of 13 April 2001, S/2001/15/Add.20 of 25 May 2001, S/2001/15/Add.26 of 6 July 2001, S/2001/15/Add.35 of 1 September 2001, S/2001/15/Add.37 of 21 September 2001, S/2001/15/Add.38 of 28 September 2001, S/2001/15/Add.39 of 5 October 2001 and S/2001/15/Add.40 of 12 October 2001.

During the week ending 13 October 2001, the Security Council, at its 4389th meeting, held on 12 October 2001, proceeded to the election of a member of the International Court of Justice, pursuant to its resolution 1361 (2001) of 5 July 2001, to fill the vacancy that had occurred as a result of the resignation of Judge and former President Mohammed Bedjaoui (Algeria) on 30 September 2001.

In the voting at that meeting, Mr. Nabil Elaraby (Egypt) received the required majority of votes in the Security Council. As Mr. Nabil Elaraby (Egypt) also received the required majority of votes in the General Assembly, he was declared elected a member of the International Court of Justice for a term of office expiring on 5 February 2006.

Also during the week ending 13 October 2001, the Security Council took action on the following item:

Nobel Peace Prize

The Security Council met to consider the item at its 4390th meeting, held on 12 October 2001 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.



The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2001/28; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-sixth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2001*).
