## Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2001/1110 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1381 (2001) (for the text, see S/RES/1381 (2001); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-sixth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2001*).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Rwanda and the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President, with the consent of the Council, extended invitations under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Judge Claude Jorda, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991, Judge Navanethem Pillay, President of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States between 1 January and 31 December 1994, and Carla Del Ponte, Prosecutor of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 and of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States between 1 January and 31 December 1994.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Belgium and the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Hédi Annabi, Assistant Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2001/1123) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations, and made an oral revision to operative paragraph 2 of the draft resolution in its provisional form.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2001/1123, as orally revised in its provisional form, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1382 (2001) (for the text, *see* S/RES/1382 (2001); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-sixth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 2001*).
