The Council of Ministers has voiced its condemnation of Israel's savage outrages and arbitrary actions against the Palestinian people in the occupied territories, which are in flagrant violation of international covenants and conventions. The Council has called upon the entire international community to meet all of its responsibilities with regard to this situation; to take action to protect the Palestinian people and ensure the removal of the blockade imposed on it; to provide support to the Palestinian National Authority; to halt the violence and brutality that is obstructing the peace process and heightening tension; and to strive for the resumption of negotiations between the two sides in the hope of achieving a just peace in the region.
