20. Agreement between the Republic of Georgia and the Republic of Bulgaria on Legal Assistance on Criminal Matters, Sophia, January 19, 1995. Requires ratification. Ratified by the Parliament of Georgia on 02.04.96. Valid since June 6, 1996. Signed on behalf of Georgia by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Georgia, I. Menagarishvili, and on behalf of Bulgaria.

2. Item 21 *should read*

21. Agreement between Georgia and Turkey on Legal Assistance on Civil, Commercial and Criminal Matters. April 4, 1996, Ankara. Ratified by the Parliament of Georgia on 27.06.96. Turkey completed the procedures on 08.10.97. Entered into force January 15, 1998. Signed on behalf of Georgia by Justice Minister T. Ninidze.
