The State of Qatar, chairman of the Organization of the Islamic Conference, has expressed its grave concern over the existing dangerous escalation between the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and the Republic of India.

An official source at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs stated that the State of Qatar, being keen on the maintenance of security and stability in both countries and the region in general, and in pursuance of the principle of good-neighbourly relations and mutual interests, calls upon the two neighbouring States to exercise self-restraint, reduce tension and appeal to wisdom for solving the crisis existing between them.
