Insert new paragraphs 3.1.11. and 3.1.11.1., to read:

- A3.1.11. In the case of temporary use spare tyres, the words "TEMPORARY USE ONLY" in upper case characters at least 12.7 mm high.
- 3.1.11.1. In addition, in the case of "T" type temporary use spare tyres, the legend "INFLATE TO 420 kPa (60 psi)" in upper and lower case characters as shown and at least 12.7 mm high.®

Paragraph 5.4.1., footnote 3/, amend to read:

". 35 (vacant), 36 for Lithuania, 38 (vacant), 39 for Azerbaijan, 46 for Ukraine, 47 for South Africa and 48 for New Zealand."

Annex 7, paragraph 1.2., the table, add for ASpeed category® AL, M and N® the value A2.4® in the column ARadial tyres Standard®, and the value A2.8® in the column ARadial tyres Reinforced®.
