Monsieur le Secrétaire Général,

By a letter dated August 28th, 1946, Nai Konthi Suphamongkhon requested that the consideration by the Security Council of Siam's application for membership of the United Nations be adjourned until a settlement of the dispute between Siam and France had been effected.

Now that such settlement has been effected as I have informed Your Excellency in a separate communication of the same date, I have the honour, under instructions from my Government, to request that the consideration by the Security Council of Siam's application be proceeded with in due course.

I avail myself of this opportunity, Monsieur le Secrétaire Général, to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
