SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF MATTERS OF WHICH
THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND OF THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Pursuant to Rule 11 of the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the
Security Council, I wish to report that as of 9 May 1947, the
Security Council is seized of the following matters:

1. The Iranian Question
2. Special Agreements under Article 43 of the Charter and the
Organization of the United Nations Armed Forces
3. Rules of Procedure of the Security Council
4. Statute and Rules of Procedure of the Military Staff Committee
5. Rules Concerning the Admission of New Members
6. Applications for Membership in the United Nations
7. The Greek Question
8. The General Regulation and Reduction of Armaments and Information
on Armed Forces of the United Nations.

The stage reached in the consideration of Items one through six and
Item eight is set forth in document S/340. The stage reached in the
consideration of Item 7 is as follows:

7. The Greek Question (See also document S/340)

By cablegram dated 5 May 1947 (document S/343) the Chairman of the
Commission of Investigation Concerning Greek Frontier Incidents informed
the President of the Security Council that the Commission had decided to
refer to the Security Council the question arising from the refusal of
Albania, Bulgaria, and Yugoslavia to appoint liaison-representatives to
the Subsidiary Group.

By cablegram dated 6 May 1947 (document S/348/Corr.1) the Chairman of the Commission of Investigation Concerning Greek Frontier Incidents requested the opinion of the Security Council concerning the appearance of the Commission in New York for presenting its report.

By letter dated 7 May 1947 (document S/347) the Representative of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics requested the Secretary General to place the Greek Question on the provisional agenda for the next meeting of the Security Council.

Items for the consideration of the above-mentioned communications were placed on the provisional agenda (document S/349) for the next meeting of the Security Council to be held on 12 May 1947.
