LETTER DATED 1 JULY 1950 FROM THE ACTING CHIEF OF THE PERMANENT
DELEGATION OF HAITI TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING
THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS OF 25 AND 27 JUNE 1950
(S/1501 AND S/1511)

I have special pleasure in informing you that, with reference to your cables of 25 and 29 June 1950, I have received instructions from my Government in the afternoon of yesterday, 30 June, asking me to inform you that the Republic of Haiti gives its full and entire approval to the Security Council resolutions concerning the Republic of Korea.

It is all the easier for us to communicate this approval since it is in conformity with the policy which we have constantly pursued since our country attained independence and which is to rally to the support of the peoples fighting for their freedom and their sovereignty and defending themselves against all aggression.

The people of Haiti and public opinion in our country cannot remain indifferent to the violation of the United Nations Charter which we signed at San Francisco five years ago and which guarantees the territorial integrity not only of the Member nations but also of the countries brought into being under the auspices of the United Nations.

The Government of the Republic of Haiti is, of course, at your disposal for any co-operation for which you may see fit to apply to it for moral support.
