LETTER DATED 5 SEPTEMBER 1950  
FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL  
TRANSMITTING 15 CABLEGRAMS FROM ORGANIZATIONS IN CHINA  
CONCERNING THE BOMBING OF CHINESE TERRITORY

New York, 5 September 1950

I am sending you herewith 15 cablegrams which I have received from trade unions, youth, women's and students' organizations and other organizations in many parts of China, and from the Sino-Soviet Friendship Association and the Committee of the Partisans of Peace, expressing indignation and protest against the barbarous bombing of Chinese territory by American aircraft.

Thus, for example, the cablegram dated 31 August from the Committee of the China Democratic League, Peking, reads as follows:

"PLEDGE ALL SUPPORT TO OUR GOVERNMENT'S FIGHT AGAINST AIR INVADERS.  
REQUEST THAT CHOU EN LAI'S CHARGES BE HEARD BY THE SECURITY COUNCIL."

In a cablegram dated 30 August various public organizations in Mukden write:

"WE SUPPORT CHOU EN LAI'S PROTEST AGAINST UNITED STATES PROVOCATION  
ATROCITIES...."

On behalf of half a million young people, the Kirin Province Student Union writes, in a cablegram dated 31 August:

"VIEW AMERICAN STRAFING CHINA AS WRECKING UNITED NATIONS SACRED  
MISSION. DEMAND YOU TAKE ACTION."

In a cablegram dated 31 August, the Kirin Province Democratic Women's Federation writes:

"SECURITY COUNCIL MUST PUNISH AGGRESSIVE ACTS OF UNITED STATES AIR  
FORCE AGAINST CHINA IN ORDER SAFEGUARD HAPPINESS OF MOTHERS AND CHILDREN  
OVER WORLD."

In a cablegram from Peking dated 31 August, the China Railway Workers Union writes:

/"CRIME OF AMERICAN

"CRIME OF AMERICAN AIR FORCE AGAINST CHINA IS CRIME AGAINST WORLD PEACE. OVER HALF-MILLION CHINESE RAILWAY WORKERS DEMAND SECURITY COUNCIL TAKE ACTION."

The women of Chungking have sent the following cablegram:

"SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND CHUNGKING WOMEN WHO EXPERIENCED WORST JAPANESE BOMBING LAST WAR WERE AROUSED TO EXTREME ANGER BY AMERICAN STRAFING CHINA. WE SUPPORT FOREIGN MINISTER'S CHARGES BROUGHT BEFORE YOU."

The Chungking Revolutionary Committee of Kuomintang states in its cablegram that the Chinese people will not permit American aircraft to violate Chinese sovereignty, and demands that the Security Council carry out the proposals made by Mr. Chou En Lai.

The Democratic National Construction Association of Chungking states in its cablegram of 31 August that it considers "the United States air aggression on China as an attempt to spread the war and undermine peace". The Tientsin Committee for Opposing United States Aggression in Taiwan and Korea and the Tientsin Council of the China Association for the Safeguarding of World Peace state, in their cablegram of 30 August, that:

"WE, THE CITIZENS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIENSIN, ARE IMMEASURABLY INDIGNANT AT THE PROVOCATIVE AND ATROCIOUS ACTS OF INVADING THE SKY OVER THE TERRITORY OF CHINA BY THE UNITED STATES AIRPLANES, AND WANTONLY MACHINE-GUNNING AND RUTHLESSLY KILLING OUR FELLOW-CITIZENS... FOR THE SAKE OF PEACE AND SECURITY OF ASIA AND THE WORLD, WE DEMAND THAT THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL IMPOSE SANCTIONS ON THIS SERIOUS CRIMINAL ACTION OF THE AMERICAN AGGRESSION FORCES IN KOREA, AND TAKE IMMEDIATE AND EFFECTIVE MEASURES TO STOP THESE ATROCIOUS ACTS OF INDISCRIMINATELY BOMBING THE PEOPLE OF KOREA AS WELL AS INVADING THE TERRITORIAL AIR OF CHINA AND STRAFING OUR FELLOW-CITIZENS ON THE PART OF THE UNITED STATES AIRPLANES..."

I request you to give instructions for the attached cablegrams to be included in the list of letters and telegrams received by the Security Council during August 1950.

Please issue this letter as a Security Council document.
