I. Introduction

1. At its 19th plenary meeting, on 20 September 2002, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-seventh session the item entitled “Administrative and budgetary coordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 6th and 15th meetings, on 3 and 24 October 2002. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee’s consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/57/SR.6 and 15).
3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General transmitting the statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system (A/57/265).

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/57/L.6

4. At its 15th meeting, on 24 October, the Committee had before it a draft decision submitted by the Chairman entitled “Statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system” (A/C.5/57/L.6).

5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/57/L.6 without a vote (see para. 6).

III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system
