



LETTER DATED 11 SEPTEMBER 1951 FROM THE ACTING SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS, TRANSMITTING THE TEXT OF THE FINAL ACT OF THE FOURTH MEETING OF THE CONSULTATION OF MINISTERS OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS

My dear Mr. Secretary-General:

Recently I transmitted to your office fifty copies* in English and French of the Final Act of the Fourth Meeting of Consultation of Ministers of Foreign Affairs, held in Washington, D. C. from 26 March to 7 April 1951. I would appreciate your transmitting these to the Security Council for its information in compliance with Article 54 of the Charter of the United Nations.

I now have the honour to send you herewith one certified copy in each of the four official languages of the Organization. These texts have been officially co-ordinated by a special committee designated for that purpose by the Council of the Organization of American States and all have equal authenticity.
